Services

Epilepsy Specific Training: Suitable for support workers, carers, workplaces, aged care workers, family members or other support people. We can also deliver training for non-epileptic seizures. Currently delivered via Zoom.

- 1. Understanding and Managing Epilepsy 1hr General Training which is a prerequisite for course 2 and 3.
- 2. Understanding the Epilepsy Management Plan 30min
- 3. Administration of Emergency Medication / Emergency Medication Management Plan 1.5hrs
